1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondents No.3 to 5.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners have already submitted a representation (Annexure P-3) to the SHO Police Station, Sherpur, Tehsil Dhuri, District Sangrur and he shall be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction

to the SHO Police Station, Sherpur, Tehsil Dhuri, District Sangrur-respondent No.2 to consider the representation (Annexure P-3) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
