The grievance of the petitioners is that their son is involved in case FIR No.64 dated 04.12.2023 registered at Police Station GRP Sangrur, District Govt. Rly. Police under Sections 170, 171, 379-B, 506, 34 of the IPC (Annexure P-2) and FIR No.335 dated 04.12.2023 registered at Police Station Civil Lines Bathinda, District Bathinda under Section 411 of the IPC (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel contends that petitioners have nothing to do with the allegations in those FIRs but simply because their son is involved, petitioners are being harassed by respondents. Petitioners even made representation (Annexure P-3) to The Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, but no action has been taken.
