1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to regularise the services of Sh. Ram Chander, late husband of petitioner, as Divisional Accountant in Haryana Agricultural Marketing Board from 16.02.2010 (Annexure P-1) i.e. the date when his junior Sh. Dhani Ram was considered to be regularised as Divisional Accountant.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a representation dated 18.11.2023 (Annexure P-8) to respondent No.2 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid representation dated representation dated 18.11.2023 (Annexure P-8) is considered and decided by respondent No.2 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. He submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, he has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/Competent Authority to consider and decide the representation dated 18.11.2023 (Annexure P-8) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
