1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the training costs amounting to Rs.22.50 lakhs along with interest @ 18% per annum.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the parties are governed by the MoA dated 11.03.2016 (Annexure P-5) and Clause 6 of the said MoA provides for arbitration, thus, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to seek alternative remedy in accordance with law.
3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
