By way of present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India, petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 26.12.2023, Annexure P-2, passed by respondent No.2, whereby his license, which is valid till 31.03.2025, has been suspended.
2. When confronted with the provision of appeal under Clause 17 of Punjab Targeted Public Distribution System (Licensing and Control) Order, 2016, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the writ petition to take recourse to the available remedy.
