1. This is an application under Section 151 CPC for placing on record affidavit of the petitioner.

2. Allowed as prayed for, subject to all just exceptions.

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3. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 02.02.2017 passed in CWP-11939-2013.

4. Counsel for the respondents has relied upon the short reply dated 09.05.2023, filed by way of additional affidavit of Dr. Anshaj Singh, Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, and has submitted that all the necessary payments, pursuant to the order dated 02.02.2017 passed in CWP-11939-2013, have already been made to the petitioner. Not only that, head-wise calculation sheet of principal amount alongwith interest and the dates of making the payment have also been mentioned in the affidavit.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
