This is a contempt petition filed with Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for non-compliance of the order dated 07.11.2023 passed in CWP-1145-2019.

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced copy of order dated 01.04.2024, vide which, the petitioner has been appointed to the post of Post Graduate Teacher Commerce (HES-II). Copy of said order is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
