Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.149 dated 07.12.2023 registered under Sections 307, 341, 427, 506, 34 of IPC read with Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Rajasansi, District Amritsar.

2. Learned State counsel made oral prayer that offence under Section 201 IPC be also added. The request is allowed.
3. The petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation with the police vide order dated 11.01.2024 passed by this Court. Today counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that by virtue of the aforesaid order the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.
4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Heera Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation. Learned State

counsel also apprised the Court that on completion of investigation, challan stands presented against the accused persons including the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 11.01.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petitioner is to join further investigation as and when called to do so by the police.
