1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.02.2023 passed in CWP-27265-2017.
2. Counsel for the respondents submits that in pursuance of the order dated 08.02.2024 passed by this Court, costs of Rs.10,000/- have been deposited with the High Court Lawyers Welfare Fund, vide receipt dated 19.02.2024. Photocopy of the said receipt is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 22.02.2023 passed in CWP-27265-2017 has been complied with and the amount has been refunded to the petitioner, as would decipher from the pay orders dated 12.03.2024 and 22.03.2024. Copies of the pay orders 12.03.2024 and 22.03.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag the same at an appropriate place.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
