The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.265 dated 01.09.2020 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 185 registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

2. As per prosecution allegations, petitioner along with co-accused was found in possession of 95 vials of intoxicating powder having salt of Buprenorphine Hydrochloride, total weighing 190 ml; apart from 104 injections of Avil on 10ml each, containing salt of Pheniramine Maleate.

3. Learned counsel contends that co-accused Ravinder Singh @ Sonu, who is similarly placed, has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 05.12.2023 in CRM-M-37205-2023 (Annexure P-3).

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Amit Rana, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.

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6. Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that case of the petitioner is on parity with co-accused Ravinder Singh @ Sonu, who has already been allowed bail vide Annexure P-3.
7. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, particularly on the basis of parity, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
