Counsel for the petitioners submits that Jaswinder Singh husband of petitioner No.1 died on 27.1.2020 and copy of his death certificate is Annexure P-3; that after the death of her husband, petitioner No.1 performed marriage with petitioner No.2 on 6.1.2024 and at that time, petitioner No.2 was unmarried. Said marriage was performed by the petitioners against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5 who are related to petitioner No.1 and the said respondents are threatening to cause harm to the petitioners and in this regard representation (Annexure P-6) dated 6.1.2024 was given to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action in this regard.

- 2. Notice of motion.
- 3. Mr. Gurdarshan Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to consider representation dated 6.1.2024 (Annexure P-6) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
