The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.407 dated 12.12.2023 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B Ipc and Sections 61(1)(C), 63A, 72A of Excise Act and Sections 103, 104 of Trade Marks Act, 1999 registered at P.S. Dharuhera, District Rewari, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 05.03.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 05.03.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 05.03.2024 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
