RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 30.11.2017 passed by the Court of Civil judge (Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana, in civil suit No.197 of 23.08.2017 and the statement dated 30.11.2017 made by them before the said Court.

2. Counsel appearing for the respondents has submitted that the managing committee of the concerned Society has already been restored by conducting fresh elections, and, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

3. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
