Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking direction to the learned trial Court to dispose of the criminal case having FIR No.11 dated 14.1.2019 registered under Sections 302, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Division -B, Police Commissionerate Amritsar, District Amritsar titled as State of Punjab v. Kawaljit Singh @ Rinku etc. in an expeditious manner.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for the last 4 years and list of prosecution witnesses provided along with the challan by the police has almost been exhausted but now one application for recall of the investigating officer has been filed by the prosecution under Section 311 Cr.P.C. just to delay the proceedings. So, prayer is made that direction be given to the learned trial Court to dispose of the trial in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Gurdarshan Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that the trial is going on and already prosecution has examined about 20 witnesses and there is no delay on the part of the prosecution to conclude its evidence.

5. In view of above, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the learned trial Court to make sincere efforts to conclude the prosecution evidence and should dispose off the trial expeditiously without granting unnecessary adjournments.
