The petitioner is seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 6 for removal of officiating employees including respondent No. 7 who are tainted and involved in various scams worth crores of rupees in the Department of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab by misusing their post.

The petitioner has given a detailed complaint/representation dated 20.02.2023 (Annexure P-27) with regard to loss of crores of rupees by misusing the power by respondent No. 7 and further to recover the loss faced by the Government.
