The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.112 dated 10.03.2023 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC registered at P.S. Israna, District Panipat.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 05.02.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Mahesh submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 05.02.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 05.02.2024 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
