This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 04.05.2022 passed in LPA-438-2019 read with order dated 12.01.2018 passed in CWP-10951-2015.

Learned counsel for the respondents has filed reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 in connected case i.e. COCP-721-2024 today in the Court. As per the said reply, the pay-scale for the post on which the petitioner was appointed is Rs.10300/- in the pay-scale of Rs.10300-34800 and this is the minimum pay-scale. There is nothing else place on record by the petitioner to show that this is not the pay-scale of the post on which the petitioner is working.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more. Hence, the same is dismissed, at this stage.
