Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.330 dated 29.09.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420 of the IPC registered at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

Status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Jitender Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind- Law and Order, District Jind has already been filed on behalf of respondent- State, received through registry. Copy supplied.

Heard.

As the status report reveals, it is co-accused Deepak son of Shyam Lal & Shyam Lal who were found to have committed cheating with lot of people and to have committed criminal breach of trust to the tune of

₹1,30,82,000/-. As far as the role of the petitioner is concerned, it is alleged that she was part of the conspiracy.

Having regard to the role as attributed to the petitioner, the present petition is hereby allowed.

It is directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. However, it is directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. She shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. She shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
