DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

It was noticed in the order dated 17.08.2023 that against the investment of ₹33,43,650/- in the company by the petitioner through various transactions from his account, he had received ₹18,41,364/- from the company and thus ₹15,02,286/- was still due towards him.

2. Learned State, on instructions from ASI Gurdial Singh, also informed that petitioner has already joined the investigation and after conclusion of the investigation, even challan has already been filed.

3. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is hereby accepted. Petitioner is allowed anticipatory bail in case FIR No.151 dated 29.10.2022 registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the

IPC registered at Police Station Cantt Bathinda, District Bathinda.

4. It is directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. However, it is directed that the petitioner shall not contact any person associated with the case to influence him during trial in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
