The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 30.11.2022, Annexure P-6, whereby non-bailable arrest warrants were issued against the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel contends that the matter has been rendered infructuous, since the petitioner's anticipatory bail was dismissed by the Supreme Court in SLP (Crl.) No. 2664-2665 of 2023 on 17.03.2023.

Thereafter he surrendered before the trial Court on 21.04.2022 and was sent to police remand.

3. In view thereof, the petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
