MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case GD No. 52 dated 18.05.2023 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.7, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-2) arising out of FIR No. 215 dated 17.05.2023 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 354, 34, 506 and 341 of IPC at the same Police Station.

2. Vide order dated 12.01.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel filed status report dated 29.12.2024. The same is taken on record. He further, on instructions states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.01.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
