KARAMJIT SINGH, J.(Oral)

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 got married with respondent No.4; that respondent No.4 was persistently harassing and torturing petitioner No.1 and as such, she left the matrimonial home and started residing with petitioner No.2 who is also already married. He further submits that the aforesaid live-in relationship is against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 who are extending threats to cause harm to the petitioners and in this regard, representation 25.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) was given by the petitioners to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action in this regard.

2. Mr. Gurdarshan Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab appearing for the official respondents submits that in case any such representation is pending, the concerned authority will look into the matter and take action in accordance with law.

3. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa to consider representation dated 25.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law in case there is any threat perception to the petitioners.

4. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 6 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
