Application is **allowed**, as prayed for, subject to all just exceptions. Exemption from filing of copy of Aadhar Card of petitioner No.2 is granted.

MAIN CASE

The present Criminal Writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondent Nos. 2 & 3 so as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

[2] Notice of motion.

[3] Mr. Shubham Kaushik, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and requisite copies of the petition have already been supplied to the learned State Counsel by learned counsel for the petitioners.

[4] Petitioner No.1-Yograj Singh aged about 21 years and petitioner No.2-Sukhpreet Kaur aged about 15 years 7 months, are stated to be in a “Live-in Relationship” against the wishes to parents of petitioner No. 2.

[5] Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and while refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed off** with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, to get representation dated 03.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) examined as regards the alleged threat perception of the petitioners and to take necessary action as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case.

[6] A copy of this order alongwith copy of the representation dated 03.01.2024 be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

[7] It is, however, clarified that the aforesaid order is not to be taken as any kind of expression as regards the relationship of the parties. It is further clarified that the aforesaid order shall not confer any immunity upon the petitioners, in case it is found that they have committed any wrong.
