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This is an application under Order 23 Rule 3 read with Section 151 CPC seeking to withdraw the main appeal as the dispute between the parties stands compromised.

It is pleaded that the original parties are real brothers and in a suit for recovery of Rs.2,84,86,199/- an amicable settlement has been arrived at between the family members. The compromise in writing is Ex.C1 in another suit, which has since been disposed of in terms of the same, vide judgment and decree dated 09.12.2023. In terms of clause 2 (V) of the terms and conditions of the said compromise, both the parties have agreed to withdraw all civil litigation against each other and



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further agreed not to initiate any proceedings relating to the matter covered therein.

In the light of compromise having been effected between the parties, the appellants seeks withdrawal of the present appeal.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, which has been filed by the original counsel and is supported by affidavit, the same is allowed.

CM stands disposed of.

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Dismissed as withdrawn.
