The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming the following reliefs:

“ii) to issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the order dated 30.04.2003 (Annexure P-3) and order dated 01.07.2003 (Annexure P-4) whereby the petitioner has prematurely been retired from the service of the Respondent-Corporation as a measure of punishment without conducting a departmental enquiry;

It is further prayed that a suitable writ, order or direction especially a writ of Mandamus be issued against the respondent-Corporation to accept the option for Voluntary Retirement Scheme submitted by the petitioner on 26.03.2003 in response to the letter dated 4.3.2003 (Annexure P-2);

It is further prayed that a suitable writ, order or direction especially a writ of Prohibition be issued against the Respondent-Corporation staying the impugned orders dated 30.04.2003 (Annexure P-3) and dated 1.7.2003 (Annexure P-4) during the pendency of the present writ petition’



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There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and respondent No.1 on the last date of hearing and notice was issued to the petitioner and respondent No.1.

Mr. T.S. Sidhu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 and he, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has unfortunately died during the pendency of the present petition. However, his LRs have not been brought on record.

In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the LRs of the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause of action still survives.
