1. This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No.1 for handing over the inquiry/investigation of the case bearing FIR No.252 dated 01.10.2023 registered under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 148/149/302/323/324/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of the SC & ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amended 2015) at Police Station Chhainsa, District Faridabad (Sections 307/120-B of IPC have been added later on) to the CBI-respondent No.7 or a high level SIT headed by an officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the grievances raised in the present petition, the petitioner has given a detailed representation (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Haryana and would be satisfied, in case the Commissioner of Police,

Faridabad is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and in case, the pleas raised by the petitioner are found to be meritorious then to take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

3. Learned State Counsel has submitted that the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, would look into the representation (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad to look into the representation (Annexure P-2), in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order and in case, the pleas raised by the petitioner are found to be meritorious then the Commissioner of Police would take necessary action, in accordance with law.

5. This Court has not opined on the merits of the case and the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, would consider the case of the petitioner independently, in accordance with law.
