GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.52, dated 28.2.2021 registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District S.A.S. Nagar, under Sections 279, 337 and 338 of Indian Penal Code and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise stated to have been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 15.1.2024, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dera Bassi has been received, wherein it has been reported that statement of petitioner/accused Kanika Gupta and also of respondents No.2 & 3 namely Amit Sharma and



Satpal Sharma have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

- 4. Respondents No.2 & 3 namely Amit Sharma and Satpal Sharma in their statements have stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
- 5. Learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dera Bassi has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any undue influence.
- 6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.52, dated 28.2.2021 registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District S.A.S. Nagar, under Sections 279, 337 and 338 of Indian Penal Code and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
