1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 18.06.2003 (Annexure P-5), whereby the petitioner has been prematurely retired from service and order dated 09.09.2003 (Annexure P-7), whereby the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 18.06.2003, has been rejected.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get further instructions from the petitioner.
3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
