1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make correction in the date of birth of the petitioner in the certificate of matriculation dated 22.07.2022 from 20.12.2006 to 20.01.2005 after taking into consideration the date of birth certificate dated 21.10.2022 and Aadhaar Card.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the grievances raised by the petitioner, the petitioner had given a representation dated 07.08.2023 (Annexure P-11) and he would be satisfied at this stage, in case, respondent No.1-Board is directed to consider the said representation dated 07.08.2023 (Annexure P-11) in a time bound manner and in case, the pleas raised by the petitioner are found to be meritorious then to grant necessary

relief in accordance with law.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1-Board to consider representation dated 07.08.2023 (Annexure P-11) in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order and in case, the pleas raised by the petitioner are found to be meritorious then respondent No.1-Board would grant necessary relief, in accordance with law and in case, respondent No.1-Board is of the opinion that the pleas raised by the petitioner are not meritorious then a speaking order rejecting the same be passed within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

4. This Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.1-Board would consider the case of the petitioner independently, in accordance with law.
