1. The petitioners have approached this Court through instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with the grievance that against the punishment order dated 09.11.2023/12.12.2023 (Annexure P-1), petitioners have preferred statutory appeal dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) and the authorities are bent upon effecting recovery.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon order dated 28.08.2023 (Annexure P-7) passed by this Court in CWP-18615 of 2023 and prays for deciding the appeal filed by the petitioners dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously by passing a speaking order within a time-bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Manbir Singh Batth, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has filed his memorandum of appearance and submits that the appeal filed by the petitioners shall be decided expeditiously.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. In view of the aforesaid stand of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with directions that the statutory appeal dated 18.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) pending before the Appellate Authority shall be decided within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further recovery from the petitioners shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the Appellate Authority.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
