1. By way of present petition, the petitioner seeks protection of life and liberty apprehending threats at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.
2. State has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Gurdev Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Malerkotla, District Malerkotla. Stand has been culled out in para No.5 thereof which reads as under:-

“5. However, it is submitted that as per the detailed facts mentioned hereinabove, the petitioner had filed application before the SSP, Malerkotla and during the process of inquiry no evidence has provided by the petitioner Sawan Sharma to substantiate allegations leveled by him. Further, he admitted in his statement that the allegations made by him, were written by him under misunderstanding which is not true. Upon which,

the inquiry. officer recommended to consign the application into record room and the application of the petitioner is pending with the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla for final approval.”

- 3. Counsel for the petitioner also expressed his satisfaction in view of the reply.
- 4. In view thereof, no further order is warranted.
- 5. Petition is disposed off.
