The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to direct the respondent No.2 not to hold multiple enquiries in a case arising out of FIR No.232 dated 01.10.2023 under Sections 406,506,120-B of IPC, Police Station Maqboolpura, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-3) and in a case FIR No.195 dated 01.10.2023 under Sections 420,465,468,471,120-B of IPC, Police Station Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-4).

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sanjay Kumar, DSP, Bureau of Investigation, Amritsar submits that in case FIR No.232 dated 01.10.2023, under Sections 406,506,120-B of IPC, Police Station Maqboolpura, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar, a cancellation report

has already been prepared and the same shall be presented before the competent Court within a period of 04 weeks from today. He further contends that in case FIR No.195 dated 01.10.2023 under Sections 420,465,468,471, 120-B of IPC, Police Station Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar, the investigation shall be concluded within a period of 08 weeks from today.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition, at this stage.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
