This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 02.09.2023 passed in CWP-18523-1998.

Learned counsel for the respondents have submitted that the order dated 02.09.2023 passed in CWP-18523-1998 has been complied with by granting necessary relief to the petitioner.
