1. Present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 115 CPC for setting aside the impugned judgment/order dated 01.11.2018 passed by learned District Judge, Mewat dismissing the appeal and affirming the order dated 01.09.2017 passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mewat dismissing the application under Order 9 Rule 13 CPC.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents stated at bar that instant revision petition has become infructuous as the learned District Judge, Nuh has finally disposed of the appeal vide judgment dated 16th August, 2023.
3. On several calls, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners.
