1. Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside sale notice dated 16.12.2023 (Annexure P-7) issued under Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 while submitting that said notice has infringed upon the right of the petitioner under Article 300A of the Constitution besides being violative of the applicable provisions of law.
