HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner is a re-employed employee and as per the clause 8 and 10 of the policy (Annexure P-1) of re-employment, the Officer on re-employment was to be allowed to continue at the same station from where he retired whereas, in the present case, vide impugned order dated 29.09.2023 (Annexure P-6), the petitioner has been transferred from Gurugram to Pataudi.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that being an obedient re-employed employee, the petitioner has joined his station in Pataudi but keeping in view the age of the petitioner, it is very difficult for him to commute up and down daily. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the post at Gurugram is still lying vacant and the

petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 27.11.2023 (Annexure P-7) with the respondents and the respondents be directed to decide the said representation sympathetically so as to re-post the petitioner at Gurugram.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the representation dated 27.11.2023 (Annexure P-7) will be considered sympathetically and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order by taking a lenient and sympathetic view keeping in view the age of the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
