[1] The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of '*Mandamus*' directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 9.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer only for issuance of a direction to decide the representations dated 16.12.2023 and 21.12.2023 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) by the official respondents.

[3] Notice of motion.

[4] Having received advance copy of the petition, Ms. Himani Arora, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No. 1 to 3.

[5] Keeping in view the innocuous prayer made, seeking written response from the respondents is dispensed with.

[6] In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (respondent No. 2) to consider and decide the representations dated 16.12.2023 and 21.12.2023 (Annexures P-1

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and P-2) and if some action is warranted, the needful be done in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
