The Punjab & Haryana High Court Bar Association and Bar Council of Punjab & Haryana High Court have decided “*No working day*” for today i.e., 22.01.2024 on account of sacred ceremony of “*Pran Pratishtha in Ram Mandir at Ayodhya*”.

The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to take legal action against the private respondents.

A perusal of the application/representation dated 09.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) reveals that the allegations seem to be serious in nature, wherein repeated beatings have been given to the petitioner with iron rods on various parts of the body including arms and chest on account of which he remained hospitalized and even the MLR is produced, which depict 4 injuries on the person of the petitioner. It is also apparent on perusal of the petitioner that due to kick blows given by the persons named in the application dated 09.01.2024, the petitioner suffered internal injuries and was advised to bed rest for one week.

Without going further into the controversy, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana to look into the application/representation dated 09.01.2024 and decide the same by passing a speaking order as well as by taking appropriate legal action on or before 29.02.2024.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

Ordered accordingly.
