The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.09, dated 31.01.2021, under Sections 307, 427, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Kabirpur (Ahlikalan), District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 02.11.2022 and thereafter the petitioner has challenged the above said order before this Court vide CRM-M-44226-2023, whereby on 04.09.2023, the Co-ordinate Bench directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of three weeks and until then, no coercive steps shall be taken against him. From perusal of file, this Court is of the view that the petitioner does not deserve the concession of regular bail, as he has surrendered before the trial Court only on 19.09.2023 in pursuance of the direction issued by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 04.09.2023.

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition at this stage.

Prayer is accepted.
