1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act against the respondents/contemnors for willful/intentional giving false, incorrect and misleading statement in CWP 3323-2020 vide order dated 13.09.2023.
2. Perusal of the order qua which the contempt is alleged, shows that there is no executable directions issued by this Court. Hence, this Court does not find any ground to proceed with the contempt petition any more.
3. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
