1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, and Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 23.09.2022 passed in CWP-17949-2022.

Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 23.09.2022 passed in CWP-17949-2022 has since been complied with and application of the petitioner has been decided by passing the order dated 26.07.2024. Copy of the order dated 26.07.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
