The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.78 dated 15.11.2022 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of the order dated 19.09.2023 and a compromise has been arrived at before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 19.09.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
