Main Case

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 18.09.2013 passed in CWP-6398-1999.

2. Pursuant to previous order dated 23.01.2024, costs has been deposited. Receipt to this effect has been placed on record. The same is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has referred to the aforesaid affidavit of Professor Ajay Bansal, Registrar (I/C) and has submitted that though the services of some of the similarly situated persons



have been regularized by the respondents, however, the service of the petitioner could not be regularized because she had already attained the age of superannuation before the date of passing of order of the Writ Court.

4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the matter.

5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
