The application has been filed by the petitioner for re-calling the order 15.03.2024, whereby the review application (RA-CW-17-2024) was dismissed for want of prosecution.

For the reasons stated in the application, duly supported by an affidavit of the counsel, the application is allowed.

Resultantly, the order dated 15.03.2024 dismissing the review application is re-called and the review application is restored to its original number and is taken up on Board today itself.

RA-CW-17-2024 in CWP-PIL-87-2023

1. This review application has been filed by the petitioner seeking review of the order dated 20.12.2023 passed in CWP-PIL-87-2023, which was dictated in the Court in the presence of learned counsel for the parties.

2. We are of the considered opinion that keeping in view the fact that it is a Public Interest Litigation and apparently, the dispute was as to how respondent No.4, who is a Government servant, had manipulated his service record, would go on to show that it is merely in the guise of grudge litigation.
3. Resultantly, we do not find any ground to review the order dated 20.12.2023.
4. The application is, accordingly, dismissed.
