The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.214, dated 30.08.2019, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 added later on), registered at Police Station, City, Rajpura, District Patiala.

This Court vide order dated 16.01.2024, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 16.01.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh, does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial

interrogation of the petitioners is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 16.01.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
