RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 read with Section 2-A of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.12.2021 passed in CWP-26431-2021.
2. It is not even in dispute that the respondents have not taken any further steps in the departmental proceedings after the date of order passed by the Writ Court. Though learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that after the order passed by this Court, the respondents have sent the inquiry report to the police and the police have registered the FIR on the same, however, it is altogether a different matter; and not connected with the process of the departmental inquiry, as such.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy qua the FIR allegedly registered against them.
