1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 01.08.2023, passed in CWP-16259-2023.
2. Affidavit on behalf of the respondent filed in the registry is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 01.08.2023, passed in CWP-16259-2023 has been complied with and necessary order dated 12/13.02.2024 has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
