1. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.1 to decide the statutory revision petitions dated 07.02.2022 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) along with applications for stay dated 07.02.2022 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) filed by the petitioners against the common order dated 10.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2, being Appellate Authority and order dated 05.12.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3, being Punishing Authority, in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for deciding the revision petitions dated 07.02.2022 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) along with

applications for stay dated 07.02.2022 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) filed by the petitioners expeditiously by passing a speaking order in a time-bound manner. He further prays that till the final disposal of the said revision petitions, no recovery be made from the petitioners.

- 4. Sh. Vikas Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the prayer made in the present writ petition.
- 5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.
- 6. Respondent No.1-Revisional Authority is directed to decide the revision petitions dated 07.02.2022 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) along with applications for stay dated 07.02.2022 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) filed by the petitioners, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
- 7. Since the statutory revision petitions filed by the petitioners are pending and yet to be decided, it will be in the interest of justice that no further recovery be effected from the petitioners.
- 8. The present petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
