The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.236 dated 13.12.2022 registered under Sections 353, 186, 294, 506 IPC and Section 52-A of Prisons Act, 1894 registered at P.S. City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.01.2024 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 18.01.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.01.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
