1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 read with Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 28.11.2023 passed in CWP-26670-2023.

2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Sudhir Rajpal, Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, School Education Department, Chandigarh, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 28.11.2023 passed in CWP-26670-2023 has since been complied with and the representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 02.02.2024 (Annexure R-1). Counsel for the respondent has also handed over a demand draft amounting to Rs.25,000/- in favour of the petitioner, to the learned counsel for the petitioner in the Court today.

Copy thereof has also been placed on record.



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4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
